

## **BLUFFS FFA ALUMNI SCHOLARSHIP**



Deadline to Apply: May 1
Please return to any Bluffs FFA Alumni Member or the Bluffs High School Ag Teacher

A scholarship will be given annually by the Bluffs FFA Alumni ("Alumni") to a Bluffs High School student ("Applicant") graduating in the current year. The Applicant must attend a trade/technical school, junior college, or four-year university. The amount of the scholarship and the number of scholarships awarded may vary from year to year, at the sole discretion of the Alumni. The Selection Committee will include the Bluffs High School Agriculture teacher and representatives from the Alumni, at least one (1) of whom must be an Alumni officer. Any Alumni member, with a child that is an Applicant, shall recuse himself from the Selection Committee. The scholarship recipient(s) will be announced at the Bluffs High School graduation ceremony.

## **Scholarship Requirements**

- 1. Applicant must be a Bluffs High School student with Senior status.
- 2. Applicant must have been enrolled in an agriculture course and/or have been an active FFA member in at least two (2) years during their high school career.
- 3. Applicant must have demonstrated a commitment to the FFA.
- 4. Scholarship, leadership, character, financial need, and commitment to agriculture will be evaluated as follows:
  - A. Scholarship 20% Determined by Applicant's cumulative GPA and attitude toward education.
  - B. Leadership 20% Determined by Applicant's involvement with FFA and other school-related organizations.
  - C. Character 20% Determined by Applicant's attitude and personal conduct both in and out of school.
  - D. Commitment to agriculture 20% Determined by Applicant's overall participation in FFA and other ag-related organizations.
  - E. Financial need 20%
